### *Confederate Treasury Notes – My Descriptions<sup>1</sup>*

17125. Type 10 PF-6. Serial number 16796. C plate. “for” printed above “Treasr”. Rare. C plate T-10s are rarer than T-11s and are rarely found above VG. Ex Ball, Fricke. Very Good. 8<sup>th</sup> finest known. (200-400)

12677. Type 13 PF-6 State I. Serial number 20189. A7. Double line box remnants around “One Hundred Dollars”. Rare. Ex Hammerly, Fricke. Choice AU. Gorgeous white color and nice, full frame line. **Tied with finest known.** (400-700)

12682. Type 16 PF-17. Serial number 17766. WA. 2<sup>nd</sup> Series. Engraver’s name under “Fundable” at left. Printed on paper watermarked “**J Whatman 1862**”. Rare and a great addition to any collection. A collection of Whatman watermarked notes remains an affordable, yet challenging goal. Ex Fricke. About Very Fine, net Fine+. **3<sup>rd</sup> finest known** in collectors’ hands. (900-1300)

17134. Type 20 PF-5. Serial number 104519. 5. First Series. B. Duncan, Richmond. Reissued in the Trans-Mississippi department with red round stamp dated February 1864. CC&A graded VF-25, cut-cancelled with cancels closed with archival tape. (150-300)

17148. Type 33 PF-8 State I. Serial number 31242. H. “Keatinge & Ball Richmond Va” facing out with a “Va’ visible. Printed on paper watermarked “CSA” in block letters. Very Rare. The rarity had been historically underestimated as some of the early shipments of CSA block paper from England were intercepted by the Union blockade. Very Good, cut-cancelled. 8<sup>th</sup> finest known. (250-500)

17151. Type 34 PF-9. Serial number 4066. J. No engraver’s names. Printed on plain paper. Underestimated as many reported T-34 PF-9s are really PF-12s on CSA block letter paper which was faint or hard to detect. Very Rare. Ex Fricke. Fine with some light foxing spots. 8<sup>th</sup> finest known. (250-500)

17154. Type 37 PF-1. Serial number 75065. B. Reissued in the Trans-Mississippi department with red round stamp dated February 1864. Fine. (250-350)

17157. Type 40 PF-5. Serial number 67008. Ah. Dated Jan 6 1863. J. T. Paterson & Co. Columbia S. C. Military issue. Issued March 26th 1863, M W Moore, Capt & AQM, ex Western Reserve. Very Fine, plus. (250-400)

17158. Type 40 PF-5. Serial number 38894. Ag. Dated Aug 24 1862. J. T. Paterson & Co. Columbia S. C. Military issue. Sept 3 1862, John Boston; J A Michaeloffsky Capt & AQM. Also, this note has McDonald, the plate engraver’s name in the margin. Rare

combination. Fine to Very Fine. Some well-hidden ink burn on reverse signature names. (200-300)

17159. Type 40 PF-5. Serial number 65687. Ah. Dated Jan 6 1863. J. T. Paterson & Co. Columbia S. C. Military issue. Originally issued by the Treasurer's office Jan 23 1862 stamp. Issued by Major C S Severson AQM, March 12, 1863. Very Good. (200-300)

17160. Type 41 PF-11. Serial number 64941. Y. Dated Nov 20 1862. Scroll 1. Inner frame line stops before "except". Printed on paper watermarked CSA in script letters. Choice Unc. (150-250)

17161. Type 41 PF-22. Serial number 79526. W. Dated Nov 27 1862. Scroll 2. Inner frame line stops before "except". Printed on paper watermarked CSA in script letters. Issued Jackson Jan 1 1863. Choice AU. (100-200)

17162. Type 41 PF-22. Serial number 45199. Y. Dated Nov 6 1862. Scroll 2. Inner frame line stops before "except". Printed on paper watermarked CSA in script letters. Choice AU. (100-200)

17164. Type 41 PF-7. Serial number 13617. X. Dated Sep 18 1862. Scroll 1. Inner frame line goes all the way under "except". Printed on paper watermarked CSA in block letters. Choice XF. Nice frame and color. (75-150)

17182. Type 57 PF-3 State II. Serial number 11957. WA. 1<sup>st</sup> Series. Keatinge & Ball Richmond Va under "Fundable" on left margin. "Va" weak, wearing away on a heavily used plate. Printed on paper watermarked CSA in block letters surrounded by a wavy line. About Very Fine. (150-250)

12723. Type 60 PF-25. Serial number 60787. H. 3<sup>rd</sup> Series. Tiny Lithographer's name. "Evans & Cogswell, Litho". Unique lithographer's name configuration across entire CSA paper money series. Rare with many in institutions or in one complete plate letter collection. Ex Western Reserve, Fricke. Fine to Very Fine with a small hole on the left side of the note, net Fine. **4<sup>th</sup> finest known** with one of the better examples in a Thian album at Duke University. (400-600)

17187. Type 63 PF-7. Serial number 40933. E. 2<sup>nd</sup> Series. Double printed serial number. Very rare error. Choice Very Good. (250-350)

## **12726. Extremely Rare 1864 Major Error Variety Collection.**

A collection of all collectible T-68 and T-69 major plate letter errors and a T-67 double ratification error as well. Only the unique T-68 PF-19 "E-A" plate letter error is missing with the only known example in the Museum of the Confederacy. This is only the third time for this set to appear at a single auction or available in a single place in over 100 years with the previous two opportunities at Dr. Douglas Ball's collection 1987 sale and the Gene Mintz collection in 2003! A great addition to a type set or a great start on a plate letter error collection and an extremely rare opportunity! Ex Fricke who put this set together as a second set to his primary collection. 6 notes. (6000-8000)

Type 67 PF-2. Serial number 5478. B. Two ratification clauses. "Six months after the ratification of a treaty of peace between..." at left. "Two years after the ratification of a treaty of peace between..." at right. Very rare. Ex Keith Edwards. Very Good, plus.

Type 68 PF-1 State III. Serial number 72306. G. No Series. Missing right plate letter "G". Rare. Ex Gene Mack. Fine, plus.

Type 68 PF-4. Serial number 85563. B-A plate letter error. 1<sup>st</sup> Series. Extremely Rare with 9 known. Ex Roswell Bank Hoard. Fine to Very Fine. 6<sup>th</sup> finest known with one of the better examples in the Museum of the Confederacy.

Type 68 PF-16. Serial number 65510. A-C plate letter error. 3 Series. Rare. Ex Keith Edwards. Fine.

Type 68 PF-17. Serial number 31435. C-A plate letter error. 3 Series. Very Rare with 11 known. Ex Keith Edwards. Fine. Tied for 7<sup>th</sup> finest known.

Type 69 PF-2. Serial number 16193. G-C plate letter error. No series. Extremely Rare with 7 known. Fine to Very Fine with a bit of printing weakness on the back. **2<sup>nd</sup> finest known.**
